



Patrick Olivelle was the Chair of the Department of Asian Studies 1994-2007, and he is currently the Mossiker Chair Emeritus in the Humanities at the University of Texas at Austin.

He was the recipient of the Guggenheim Fellowship, and was elected President of the American Oriental Society in 2005.

His books have won awards from the American Academy of Religion and the Association of Asian Studies.

In 2011 he was awarded the Career Research Excellence Award of the University of Texas, at Austin.

He has published over 25 books and over 50 scholarly articles.
