MASTER OF ARTS IN DEVELOPMENT, ENVIRONMENT, SOCIETIES, AND HISTORY OF SOUTH ASIA

This **two-year degree** is one of three Masters degrees offered by the South Asia Institute of Heidelberg University, Germany. The **classes are taught in English**, in small group formats comprising students from all over the world.

Students can choose from a large selection of classes to support a **research-oriented program** that engages with **historical, social, and current political and economic developments and events**, as well as **geography and environment** in the countries of South Asia.

The goal of the program is to familiarize students with **interdisciplinary approaches** from various fields in the humanities and social sciences and to enable them to **work independently and self-reflectively**. Students choose a focus area, which they can supplement it with other courses, including languages.

The following **focus areas** can be selected: Political Science Geography

History Anthropology

Development Economics Art History and Visual Culture

With our branch offices in several South Asian countries, and many visiting scholars from all over the world, we provide an environment for interdisciplinary applied learning and research.

Application Deadline for Summer Semester 2023: March 31, 2023

Application Deadline for Winter Semester 2023/24: May 01 to September 30, 2023

Applicants are advised to **start the process early**, especially if they require visas.

Applicants must hold an **above average Bachelor's degree** in one of the focus areas or a related discipline. Other applicants may be eligible if they can demonstrate proficiency in these disciplines.
