## Writing Ambedkar The Biography of Bhiva, Bhima, Bhimrao

Prof. Suraj Yengde - Harvard University



Suraj Yengde is the author of the acclaimed book *Caste Matters* (2019), and the co-editor, with Anand Teltumbde, of *The Radical in Ambedkar* (2018). A research associate at Harvard University, he is currently working on *Caste: A New History of the World*, due out later this year, and on a biography of Ambedkar. As an academic and activist, he is working towards developing a critical theory of Black and Dalit Studies, recently collaborating with the philosopher Cornell West.

Dr. Yengde will be visiting Heidelberg to deliver a talk based on his work on writing about Ambedkar (at the above date), and to teach a masterclass on the Poona Pact (on June 15, at 11am).
